Informational Items

House Bill 117/ Ca. Co. Ordinance 2017-02

The above documents were presented for review. There were many sections redacted from the House Bill document, so research will be done and a clear summary prepared for the next meeting. The accompanying Caroline County Ordinance will also be reviewed prior to the next meeting so that those portions that are of importance to the Town of Greensboro can be presented for discussion.

Recovery House

The Greensboro Hotel has been purchased by Cox Creek, LLC; an investment company owned by Terri Sprouse, the wife of Dr. Sprouse. Dr. Sprouse is moving forward with his recovery house and has begun renovation on the building.

Mr. Schaffner asked what, if anything, the Town has done in an effort to prevent the recovery house from becoming established. It was explained to Mr. Schaffner that the Town has no standing to forbid the use. The duty to provide reasonable accommodations to qualified individuals with disabilities is a statutory requirement of the Americans with Disabilities Act. Recovering addicts *are* considered disabled and therefore protected.
