

Town Council Open Meeting Requirements

Mayor and Council strongly encourage that you continue to attend the meetings via Zoom as it is the best way to protect yourself and others. These are not guidelines; they are requirements.

- Please contact Town Hall at (410) 482-6222 to request a seat. There are only eight (8) available due to social distancing requirements.
- Masks are required at all times. Town Council will remove their masks once seated so that they can be heard. If you are speaking, you will be asked to stand at your seat to address council but you must keep your mask on.
- Anyone entering the meeting hall will be required to have their temperature checked with a non-contact infrared thermometer. If you have a temperature in excess of 100.4°F, you will not be permitted in the meeting hall.
- There will be hand sanitizer inside the meeting room and you are required to use it upon entry.
- You must be seated immediately in order to maintain social distancing.
- People exhibiting any of the following symptoms should attend via Zoom. While we realize these symptoms are also associated with allergies or other illnesses, we are taking the necessary precautions to ensure residents remain healthy.
 - Fever or chills
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Fatigue
 - Muscle or body aches
 - Headache
 - Loss of taste or smell
 - Sore throat
 - Congestion or runny nose
 - Nausea or vomiting
 - Diarrhea
