Hurricanes and Nor'easters—are you prepared?!



The mid-Atlantic is subject to extreme weather, including tropical systems and Nor'easters. There are precautions that you can take to help keep you, your family and pets safe.

- Check around your home for unsecure objects that can become projectiles in high winds. Secure objects or put them inside.
- Keep an emergency supply kit, including flashlights, batteries, first-aid supplies, water, food (including non-perishable food items), cash, medication and person identification.
- Ensure there is sufficient food and water for pets. Have crates to transport if necessary.
- Make sure cell phones are charged
- Turn refrigerator and freezer to a colder setting and keep doors closed as much as possible to prevent food spoilage.
- Have plenty of warm clothes and blankets for potential power loss from a Nor'easter.
- Pay attention to and heed warnings!

Water and Sewer Bills/ Shut Off Days

Just a reminder, this quarter's water bills will be due October 30, 2020! You can make payments up until that date without signing a payment agreement; however, if your balance is not paid in full by 10/30/2020, you will need to come into Town Hall and sign an agreement. Shut-off day, if payments or payment arrangements are not made, will be November 19, 2020. If you will be making payment arrangements the following will be the due dates and shut-off days. All payment arrangements will need to be made by signing an agreement which can be obtained in Town Hall.

11/28/2020	Final Payment	12/01/2020

*Shut-offs for non-payment will resume when COVID restrictions are lifted.
