Water and Sewer Bills/ Shut Off Days

Just a reminder, this quarter's water bills will be due January 30! You can make payments up until that date without signing a payment agreement; however, if your balance is not paid in full by 01/30 you will need to come into Town Hall and sign an agreement.

Shut off day if payments or payment arrangements are not made will be February 18.

If you will be making payment arrangements the following will be the due dates and shut off days. All payment arrangements will need to be made by signing an agreement which can be obtained in Town Hall.
