AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GREENSBORO ESTABLISHING A VACANT LOT FEE OF \$36.42 PER QUARTER TO COVER THE TOWN'S WASTEWATER TREATMENT SYSTEM DEBT SERVICE, TO BE ASSESSED AND COLLECTED AGAINST ANY VACANT LOT WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF GREENSBORO WITH AN EXISTING CONNECTION TO THE TOWN'S WASTEWATER SYSTEM

Comm. Williamson made a motion to approve Ordinance 2017-O-10; Comm. Mackey seconded the motion. All approved

<u>Bills</u> Bills were reviewed and approved.
