Just a reminder, this quarter's water bills will be due 01/31/2022. You can make payments up until that date without signing a payment agreement; however, if your balance is not paid in full by 01/31/2022, you will need to come into Town Hall and sign an agreement. Shut-off day, if payments or payment arrangements are not made, will be 02/15/2022. If you will be making payment arrangements the following will be the due dates and shut-off days. **All payment arrangements MUST be made by signing an agreement which can be obtained at Town Hall.**
