Town Manager Kelledees presented the budget paperwork to all the council.

Discussion on the following:

- There has been a line added to Community support for Greensboro Connects.
- 4% has been built in for Salaries but may not be that much.
 - Commissioner Breliia asked if we could possibly give COLA (of the same amount to everyone) instead of percentages if feasible.
- The possibility of removing two officers that are budgeted.
 - Discussion on the Caroline County Criminal Investigation Department
 - Having the County take care of policing our town vs paying our own.
- WWTP & Rates
 - Tammy spoke with Rural Water, and we can do an apprenticeship with a current employee as an option when considering the next company.
 - The water/sewer plant needs to be self-sufficient. Even if we acquire a loan the funds must be only for that.
 - The tiered rates on water/sewer make it fairer.
 - The Mayor and the Council asked for proposed water rates for the \$135,000 company and the \$300,000 company as quickly as possible to have an informed discussion at the public hearing.
- There should be federal funding for the lead/copper pipe when it needs to be done.
- Discussion on East Lift Station and that a basket strainer may be an option.

Mayor Spencer asked for a motion to adjourn.

Motion to adjourn made by Commissioner Noon and we seconded by Commissioner Breliia at 8:14 pm. All in favor.
